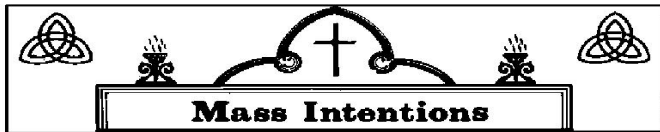

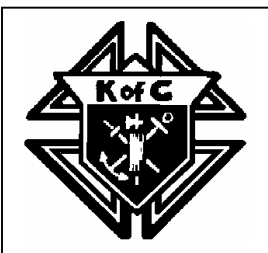

*“Ask the Lord of the harvest to send out labourers into his harvest.” (Matthew 9:38)*

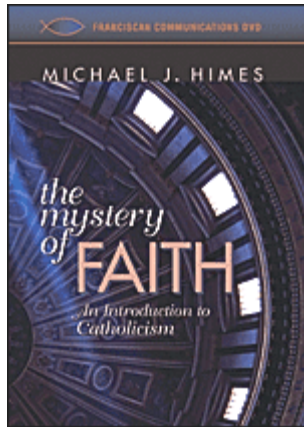
