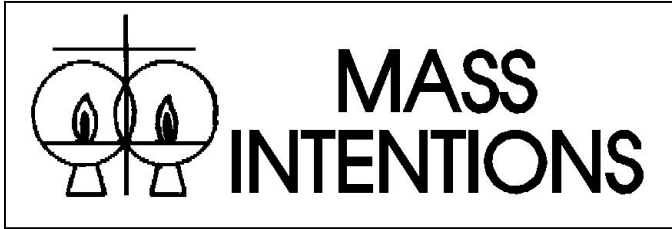

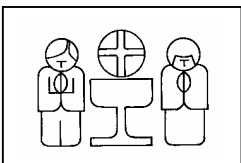

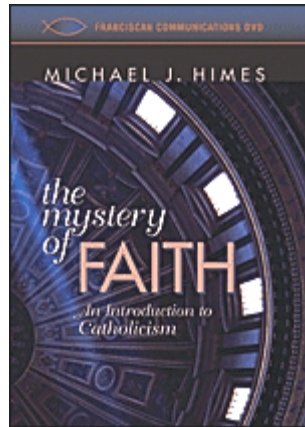
DIOCESAN WEDDING ANNIVERSARY MASS

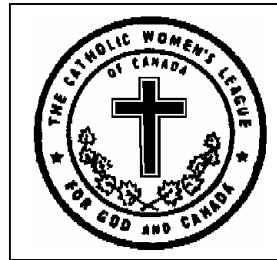
