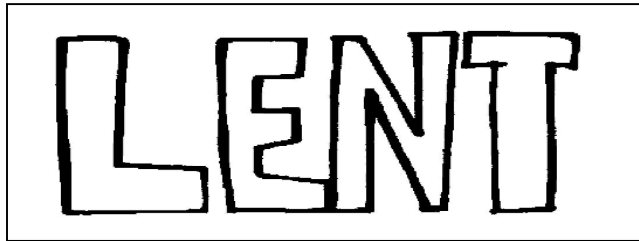

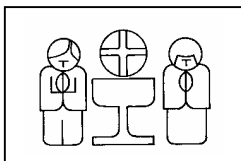

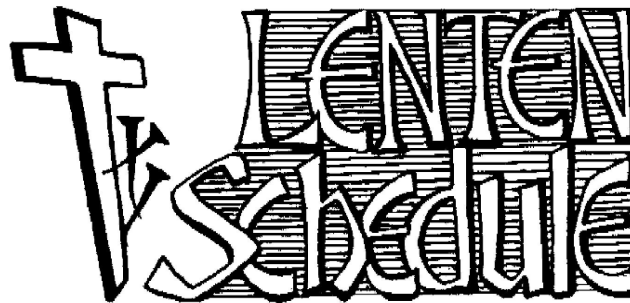
**ADORATION OF THE
