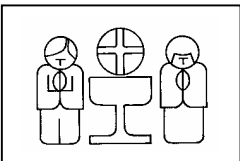

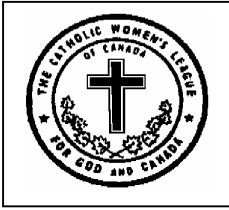
On Friday evenings of Lent at 7:00p.m. there will be
