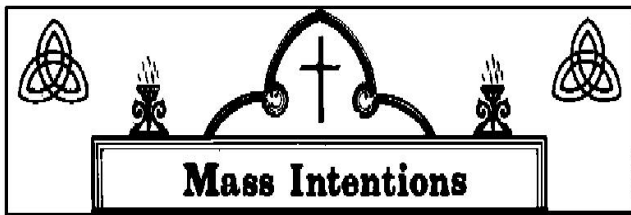

The Diocesan Library and Archives are open to the public in order to facilitate and promote a greater understanding of our faith and history.

LIBRARY MISSION

The Purpose of the Diocesan Library is to assist our Catholic community in its faith journey through audio-visual and print materials. Our resources include titles on: Catechetics, Family Life, Liturgy, Personal Enrichment, Prayer, R.C.I.A., Religious Education, Sacrament Preparation, Social Awareness, Spirituality and Vocations.

The *Library Catalogue* is a tool that allows users to search and reserve Diocesan Library Materials online.

ARCHIVES MISSION

The Diocese of Hamilton Archives is mandated through the Code of Canon Law to collect, preserve, and provide for research, the official records of the Diocese. The Diocesan Archives seeks to promote and understanding of the origins, developments and objectives of the Diocese as reflected in the workings of its agencies, institutions, and offices.

The *Diocesan Archives Database* is a service that gives people access to descriptive records, which detail items in the Archives' collection. The Archives Database is not a complete inventory of our holdings. It is updated regularly to provide both historical and current material.
